## **RoHS III Declaration**

Directive 2011/65/EU

amended by (EU) 2015/863 and (EU) 2017/2102

The EU Directive entitled "Restriction on the use of certain Hazardous Substances (RoHS) 2002/95/EC", became effective the 1st of July 2006. This regulation restricts the use of six substances within electrical and electronic equipments. This directive was revised on June 2011 and now is included into Directive 2011/65/EU. On 4 June 2015, the EU commission has published a new Directive (EU) 2015/863 to amend Annex II to EU RoHS 2 (Directive 2011/65/EU) to add the following 4 phthalates onto the list of restricted substances. On Directive (EU) 2017/2102 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 15 November 2017 amending Directive 2011/65/EU on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (Text with EEA relevance. ) The restricted substances still remain the same.

The substances subject to specified limits are:

•	Lead (Pb)	< 1,000 ppm
	Mercury (Hg)	< 1,000 ppm
•	Cadmium (Cd)	< 100 ppm
	Hexavalent chromium (Cr6+),	< 1,000 ppm
	Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)	< 1,000 ppm
•	Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE)	< 1,000 ppm
	Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP):	< 1000 ppm ( (EU) 2015/863 Amendment)
	Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP):	< 1000 ppm ( (EU) 2015/863 Amendment)
•	Dibutyl phthalate (DBP):	< 1000 ppm ( (EU) 2015/863 Amendment)
•	Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP):	< 1000 ppm ( (EU) 2015/863 Amendment)
